



What are we learning this term in....?

Term 1 Aug – Oct 2020

The focus initially this term is very much on reintegrating as a class, concentrating on the health and wellbeing of all. Part of this has been working hard to create our Class Charter, with the children selecting what they felt were the most appropriate articles from the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC).

Games and game play will feature across the year in P6 as part of our learning. Sometimes to practise specific skills (for example money handling in Monopoly), but also to consider **how** we learn, revisiting and expanding on metacognition (essentially, thinking and talking about how we learn) and how skills can be transferred from one context to another.
